1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 325F.992, subdivision 3, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 3. **Penalties; remedies.** In addition to any other remedies available under the law,
 1.8 the military beneficiary injured by a violation of this section may bring a cause of action to
 1.9 recover damages, reasonable attorney fees and costs, ~~or~~ and equitable relief related to a
 1.10 violation of subdivision 2. The attorney general may enforce this section pursuant to
 1.11 applicable law.
