Racial gaps in Minnesota's graduation rates indicate these unfavorable odds disproportionately affect Black, Indigenous and students of color.

By tapping into and building upon the proven career pathways model, we can reduce disparate educational outcomes and fortify our region's much-needed talent pool. All while giving future leaders of our community clear pathways to wealth-building careers with zero college debt.

POTENTIAL OF OUR IMPACT -

A \$10 million investment over the next five years would power the already successful Career Academies initiative. Together, with district partners, we can help students gain work experience, earn intentional credits in high-demand fields and transition into familysustaining careers


