Overview

H.F. 2925 includes in the levy portion of LTFM funding (above the \$380 per pupil unit) the costs necessary for a school site to remodel an existing restroom or to construct a new gender-neutral single-user restroom.

For planning purposes, has school districts include any plans for gender-neutral single-user restrooms in the district's LTFM ten-year plan.

Requires major remodeling and construction projects to include plans for gender-neutral single-user restrooms in the materials submitted for the commissioner of education's review and comment.

| 1 | <p>Long-term facilities maintenance revenue.</p> <p>Adds on top of the per pupil formula for Long-Term Facilities Maintenance (LTFM) revenue (\$380 per pupil unit), the cost of remodeling an existing restroom or constructing a gender-neutral single-user restroom for each school site in the district.</p> <p>Removes obsolete language.</p> |
| 2 | <p>Long-term facilities maintenance revenue for a charter school.</p> <p>Removes obsolete language.</p> |
| 3 | <p>Facilities plans. [LTFM]</p> <p>Requires each school district's ten-year LTFM plan to address whether the ten-year LTFM projects will include providing a gender-neutral single-user restroom at each school site.</p> |

4	LTFM equalization revenue. Removes obsolete language.
5	LTFM equalized levy. Removes obsolete language.
6	LTFM unequalized levy. Removes obsolete language.
7	LTFM equalized aid. Removes obsolete language.
8	Allowed used for LTFM revenue. Authorizes a school district to use LTFM revenue to remodel or construct a gender-neutral single-user restroom at each school site.
9	Restrictions on LTFM revenue. Under current law, LTFM funding cannot be used for new construction. Exempts new construction and remodeling of existing facilities for at least one gender-neutral single-user restroom at each site from the general prohibition of using LTFM revenue for new construction.
10	Information required. [Review and Comment] Includes in each district's review and comment for new facilities a description of the project's plans for gender-neutral single-user restrooms, locker room privacy stalls, or other spaces with privacy features, including single-user shower stalls, changing stalls, or other single-user facilities.
11	Uses of total operating capital revenue. Makes clear that a school district may use its current operating capital for gender-neutral single-user restrooms, locker room privacy stalls, or other spaces with privacy features, including single-user shower stalls, changing stalls, or other single-user facilities.
12	Appropriations; Gender-neutral single-user restrooms. Appropriates an unspecified amount of funds for gender-neutral single-user restrooms. Authorizes a school district or cooperative unit to apply for a grant of not more than \$50,000 per site for remodeling, constructing, or repurposing space for gender-neutral single-user restrooms.
