









Increase State Investment in Victim Services

February 1, 2021

In collaboration, Minnesota's coalitions working to end violence and abuse request the State invest in victims/survivors.

- \$4 million annual investment for Emergency Funds and Direct Client Assistance to support the needs of domestic and sexual violence victims and the victims of other crimes. Current funds are woefully inadequate to address basic needs of crime victims. Administered by the Department of Public Safety's Office of Justice Programs (DPS/OJP).
- ➤ \$10 million annually for community-based programming including domestic abuse transformation programming and restorative and transformative justice initiatives. Funded through the Department of Corrections and administered by DPS/OJP.
- > \$1 million annually to sustain and strengthen the Domestic and Sexual Violence Prevention competitive grant program that was initiated by the Council of Asian Pacific Minnesotans. This will continue funding of a 2019 appropriation that is administered by the Department of Health.
- \$7.5 million annual increase to fund housing through the Emergency Services Program (ESP). ESP funding provides emergency shelter and safety from COVID-19 and violence (through congregate, scattered site, and motel settings). Domestic and sexual violence is a leading cause of family homelessness. Additionally, adults and children experience high rates of violence while homeless. This investment in ESP funding will directly benefit victim/survivors, help them to gain safety, and prevent further violence. A Minnesota Coalition for the Homeless initiative administered by the Department of Human Services/Office of Economic Opportunity.
