Bill Description

Dentistry profession licensure, registration, scope of practice, continuing education, and disciplinary grounds modifications

Assumptions

The bill contains many policy changes that have no fiscal impact.

Updates to the licensure database will be minor and will be covered by routine maintenance. This is a small IT cost that can be absorbed.

The fee associated with allowing guest renewal does not change too much as we are only moving from annual renewal to biennial renewal.

The guest dental therapist fee addition does not have large fiscal impact, as it is a \$50 fee and <5 per FY is anticipated.

The other fees are nominal, as an example, duplicate certificate for limited radiology registrants in the amount of \$10. There are only 200 LRR's total in the state. They would not all need duplicate annual registration cards.

In conclusion, the fees added are nominal and are added to the statute to align with licensure/registration for dentistry and other allied professions regulated by the Board.
