

TRANS REFUGE STATUS IN MINNESOTA

In 2023, Minnesota was established as a Trans Refuge state, sending a clear message that Minnesota is a safe place for LGBTQIA2S+ people to live, work, and seek care. This law has been critical during the rise of anti-LGBTQIA2S+ legislation and attacks.

Following the passage of the Trans Refuge bill, PFund and community partners began tracking the movement of individuals and families to Minnesota. Our data collection – just a small segment of the full picture – has revealed that **more than 150 individuals and families have or are soon moving to Minnesota**. Additionally, more than 85% are seeking culturally competent, affirming medical and mental healthcare.

TRANS REFUGE NEXT STEPS

Providers of gender-affirming care are reporting waitlists of 200-400 people with wait times for an initial appointment often a year or more. The need for gender-affirming care far outweighs provider capacity.

Minnesota urgently needs to increase access to quality and competent healthcare for trans-Minnesotans and those seeking refuge in our state to uphold the promise of safety and opportunity in Minnesota for LGBTQIA2S+ people.

OVERVIEW

With \$1m from the state of Minnesota, PFund Foundation and partners will **expand the state's gender-affirming care workforce** by establishing grant-funded training programs at gender-affirming care healthcare facilities.

Trainees will participate in a PFund-hosted cohort to expand learning opportunities, deepen knowledge, and create community.

Trans Refuge Relocation Data

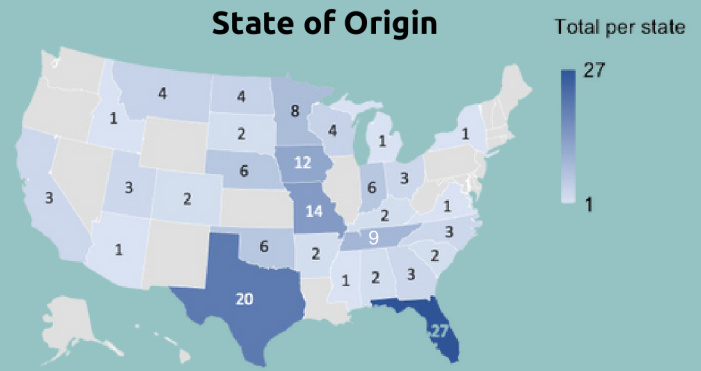
Overview

A survey was administered by Twin Cities Pride and data was collected from several LGBTQ+ serving organizations in Minnesota between July 1, 2023 and January 8, 2024. The data includes responses from **151 individuals and families** who have or are soon relocating to Minnesota for Trans Refuge purposes.

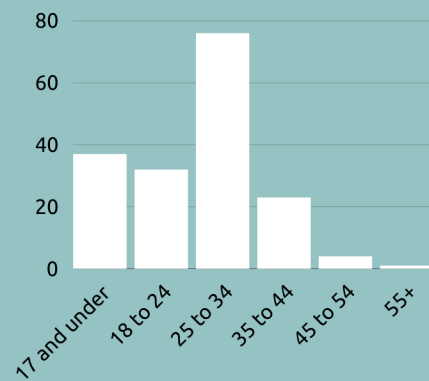
We know that this is not a holistic picture, and there are dozens, if not hundreds, more people not reflected in this survey. The information in this survey can help ensure we supply adequate resources and continue making Minnesota a beacon of hope.

At A Glance

- Data collected from 151 individuals and families in ~6 months
- 50 respondents moving with their families
- Of those in need of healthcare, 80% need it within 1-3 months
