

Subject Continuous MA eligibility for children

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## Overview

This bill provides 12 months of continuous MA eligibility for children under age 21.

## Summary

Section	Description
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1	<b>Period of eligibility.</b>
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Amends § 256B.056, subd. 7. Allows a child under age 21, once determined eligible for MA, to be continuously eligible for the program for up to 12 months, unless:

- 1) the child reaches age 21;
- 2) the child requests voluntary termination of coverage;
- 3) the child ceases to be a Minnesota resident;
- 4) the child dies; or
- 5) the agency determines that eligibility was erroneously granted to the child due to agency error or enrollee fraud, abuse, or perjury.

States that the section is effective January 1, 2024, or upon federal approval, whichever is later.
