## All Cases Received, 2018-2022



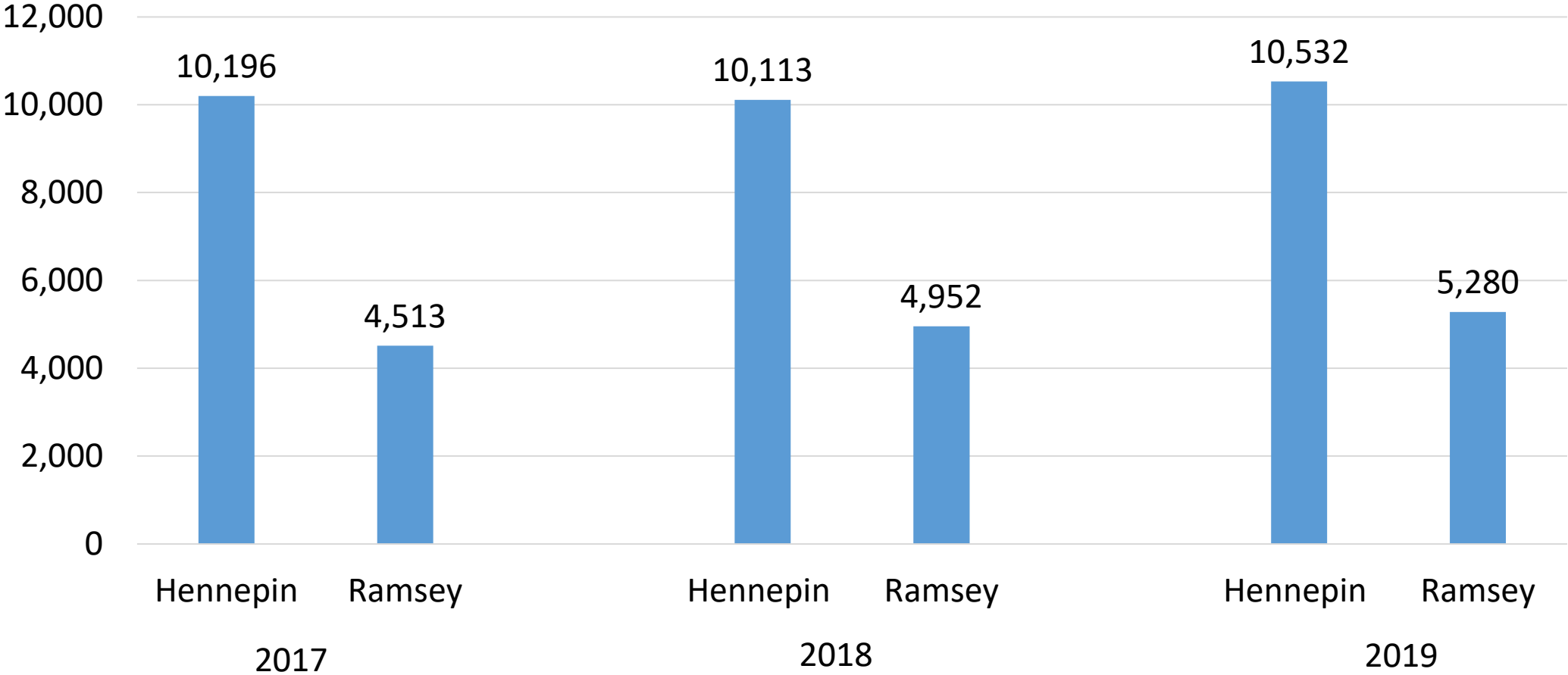
### Cases by Offense Type

Robbery	2,486	3.97%

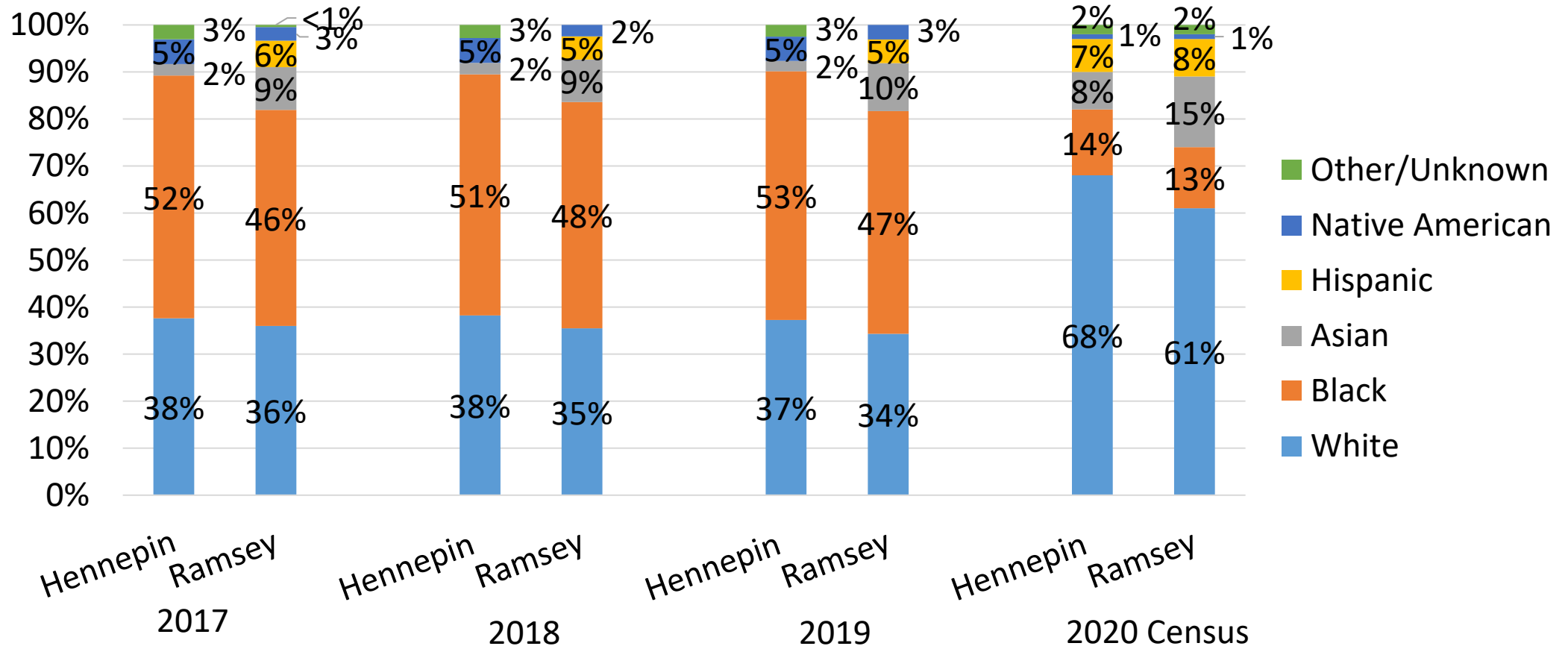

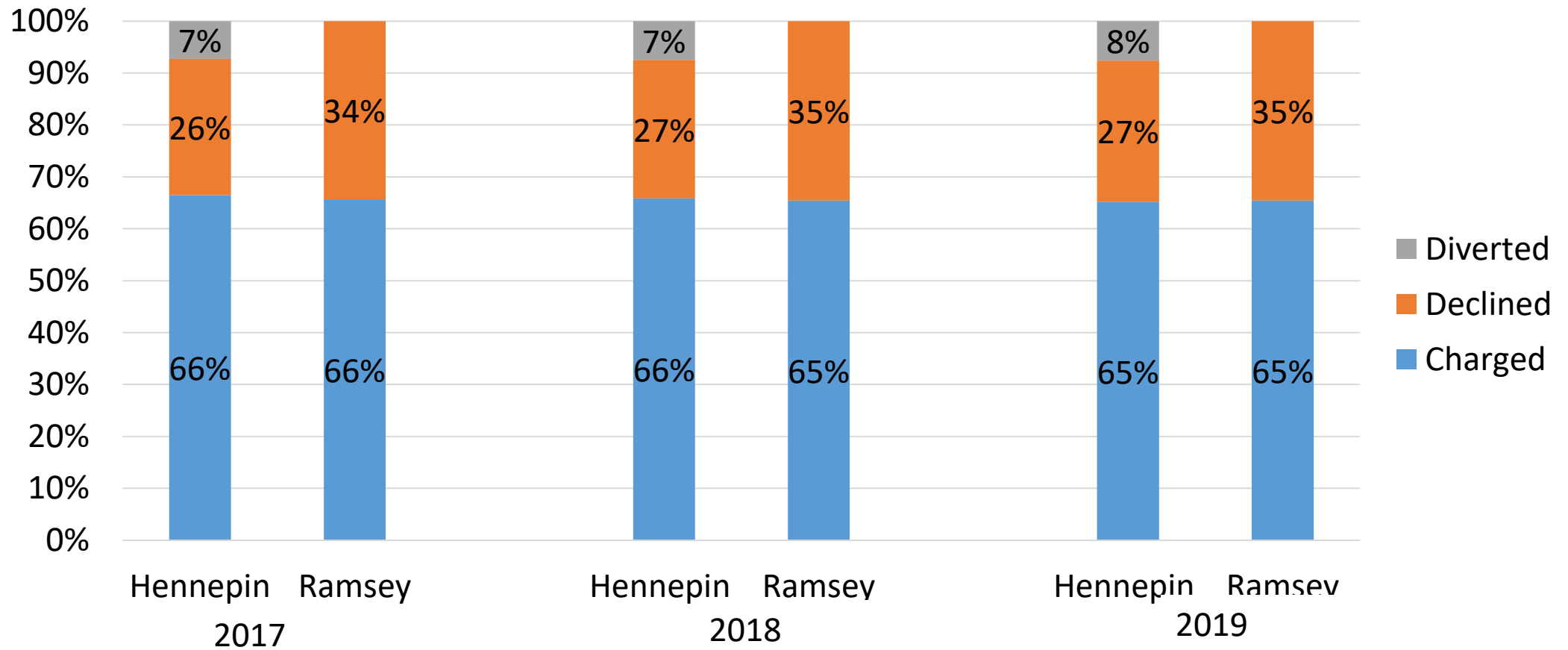
# Cases Referred to Hennepin and Ramsey County Attorneys for Prosecution (Adult Only)
