Summary

This bill authorizes counties to set speed limits on roads under their respective jurisdictions without a prior engineering and traffic study or authorization by the Minnesota Department of Transportation. Under the provision, the county must develop procedures for setting speed limits based on safety, engineering, and traffic analysis. It would go into effect August 1, 2022.

The change modifies speed limit setting authority that had been provided to cities in 2019 legislation.
