Summary

This bill removes the requirement for health care and social services professionals (who are mandated reporters of suspected child maltreatment) to report a woman's use of a controlled substance for a nonmedical purpose or excessive consumption of alcohol during pregnancy to the local welfare agency, if the professional is providing or collaborating with other professionals to provide the woman with prenatal care, postpartum care, or other health care services, including care of the woman's infant.
