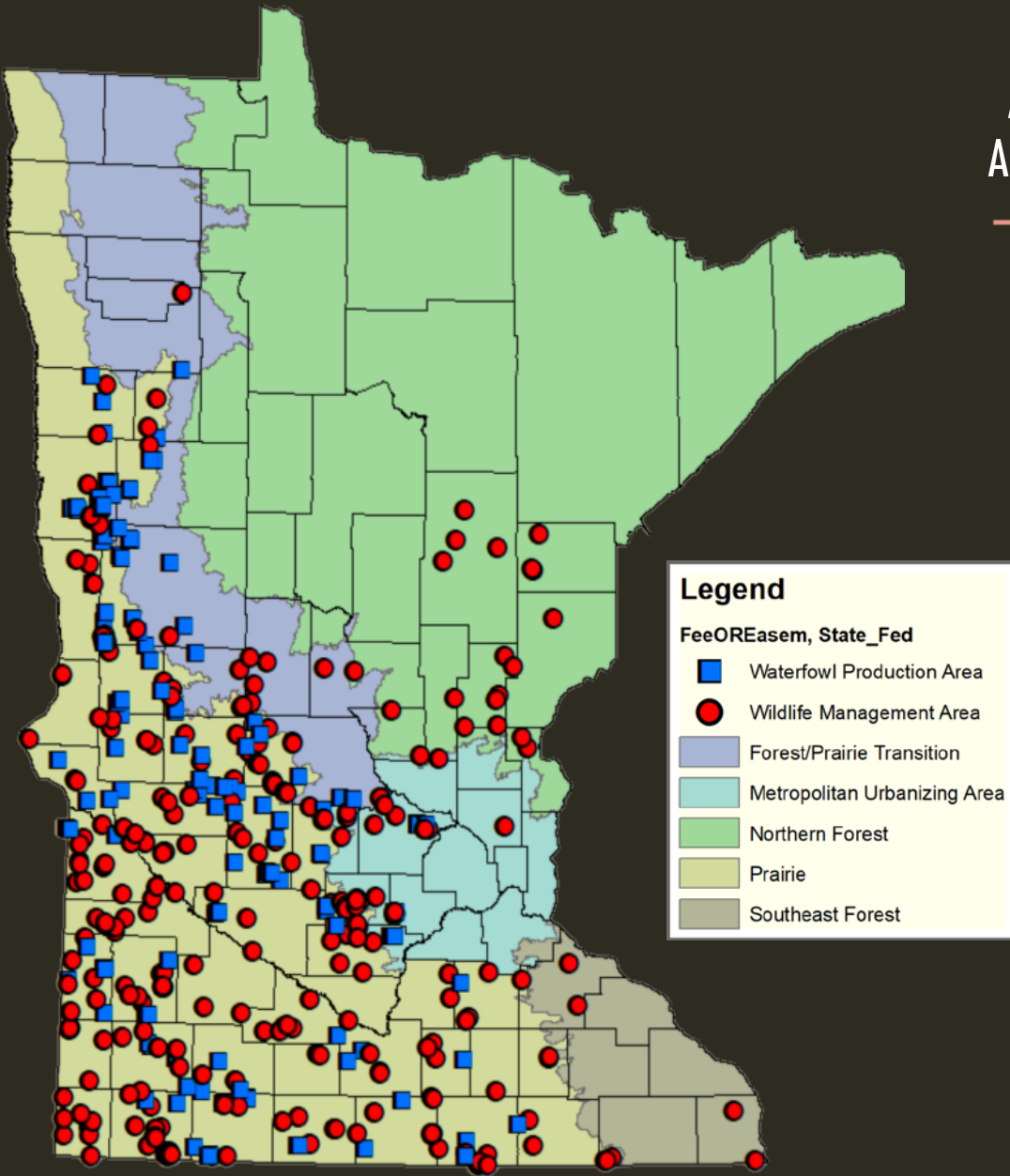


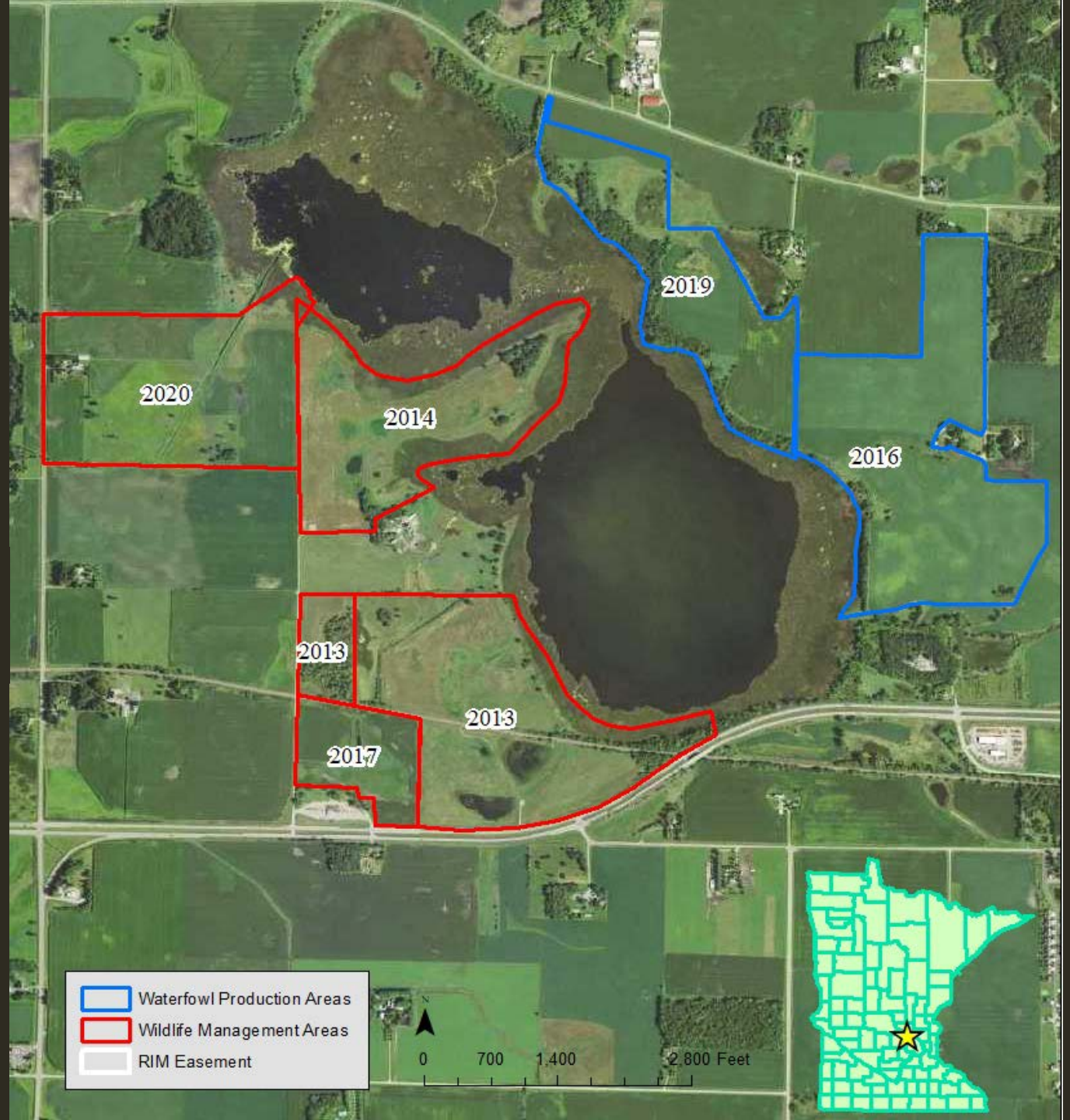

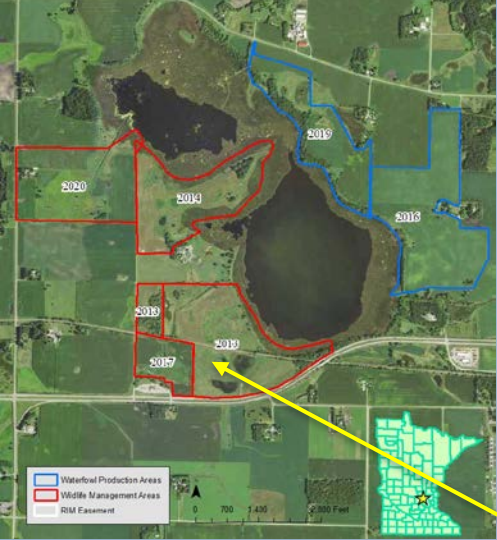


- 13 phases of OHF funding

- 35 total partners

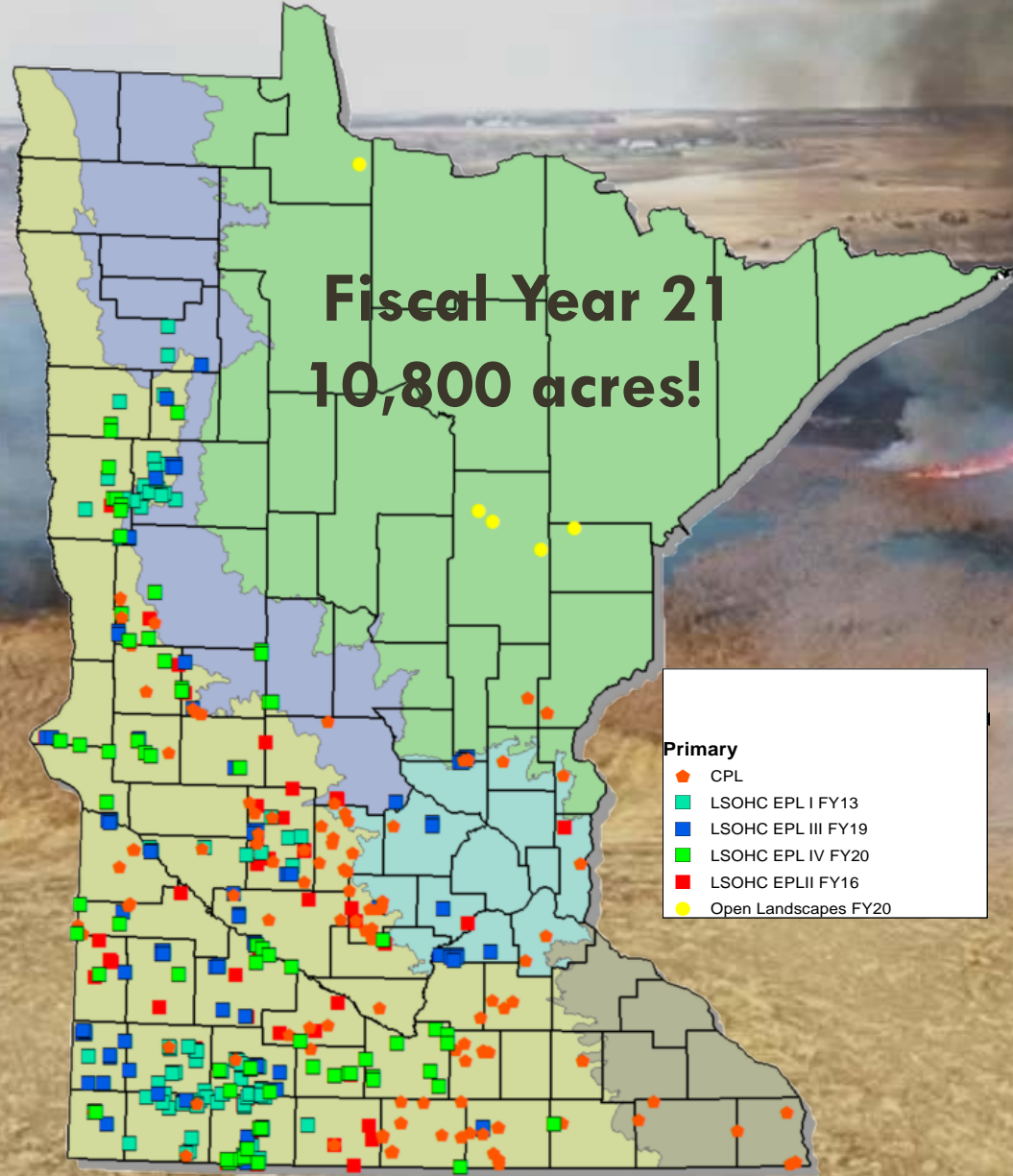


USFWS HAPET Analysis

Species	Estimated Wildlife Response after Restoration
Pheasants	47.4% increase in pheasant population index (within a 2 mile radius)
Ducks	31.1 acres of restored wetlands will provide habitat for 23.3 breeding waterfowl pairs
Monarchs	637% increase in additional monarchs to the over-winter population
