1.2 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

1.3 "Section 1. **[142B.665] CHILD CARE CENTER ACCESS.**

1.4 Subdivision 1. **Definitions.** (a) The following terms have the meanings given for the  
1.5 purposes of this section.

1.6 (b) "Child care center" means:

1.7 (1) a child care center licensed under Minnesota Rules, chapter 9503; and

1.8 (2) a certified license-exempt child care center authorized under chapter 142C.

1.9 (c) "Employee" means the license holder, authorized agent, controlling individual,  
1.10 director, staff persons, substitutes, and unsupervised volunteers of a licensed child care  
1.11 center or a certified license-exempt child care center.

1.12 (d) "Judicial officer" means a judge or justice of the United States, a United States  
1.13 magistrate judge, or a clerk of the court authorized to sign a warrant pursuant to rule 9 of  
1.14 the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure.

1.15 Subd. 2. **Limits on access by officials engaged in immigration enforcement.** (a) An  
1.16 employee of a child care center must not consent to a federal, state, or local official entering  
1.17 a child care center for the purposes of civil immigration enforcement unless the official  
1.18 provides the employee with a warrant signed by a judicial officer authorizing the arrest of  
1.19 a particular individual. The employee must request that the federal, state, or local official  
1.20 provide valid identification and a written statement of purpose.

1.21 (b) If a federal, state, or local official engaged in civil immigration enforcement enters  
1.22 a child care center, an on-duty employee must immediately notify the child care center  
1.23 license holder or authorized agent.

2.1 (c) This section does not prohibit entry by a state, federal, or local official administering  
2.2 a state or federally supported child care program.

2.3 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment."
