Child Credit and Working Family Credit Calculation (Tax Year 2023)


- Child Credit and Working Family Credit combined, jointly phased out.
 - Old law WFC gave larger amounts for taxpayers with children.
- Child Credit \$1,750 per qualifying child ages 0-17.
- Working Family Credit equal to 4% of first \$8,750 of earned income (\$350 maximum credit)
- Phaseout:
 - Jointly phased out at \$35,000 of income for married filers
 - Jointly phased out at \$29,500 for unmarried
- Working Family Credit for older children, closely tied to old law amount for the Working Family Credit:
 - \$925 for taxpayers with 1 older child, \$2,100 for taxpayers with 2 older children, \$2,500 for taxpayers with 3 older children.
- Older children: All 18 year-olds; 19-24 year-olds who are students or who are permanently and totally disabled
