Summary

This bill modifies hours of instruction requirements for high school students. School boards are required to provide 1,020 hours of instruction for high school students each school year, not including summer school. This bill would allow a board to include in those minimum hours the time that the board determines a student is actively engaged in the educational process of the district and all other relevant programmatic statutory requirements are met. The educational process must provide learning opportunities and services through implementation of evidence-based practices, quality instruction, and personalized learning supports. The bill lists optional components of the educational process.
