Overview

This bill establishes license plates for rental motor vehicles.

Summary

Section Description

1 [Adds § 168.1289] Rental motor vehicle plates.

Establishes a rental motor vehicle license plate. Sets eligibility, identifies eligible vehicles, specifies application requirements, provides for plate design, and sets plate transfer requirements. Effective the earlier of July 1, 2026, or once the plates are made available.

- **Subd. 1. Definitions.** Defines terms, which includes establishing that an auto rental company must rent at least 50 motor vehicles based on a daily rental rate.
- **Subd. 2. Issuance of plates.** Provides for issuance of rental motor vehicle plates under various requirements. Identifies types of vehicles for which the plates can be obtained.
- **Subd. 3. Design.** Sets out the plate design, including the inscription "rental motor vehicle."
- **Subd. 4. Plates transfer.** Provides for transfer of plates across vehicles. Authorizes a deputy registrar to retain collected transfer fees.
- **Subd. 5. Exemptions.** Exempts the plates from (1) special plate application requirements, and (2) display of registration stickers.
