Subject Higher Education: Paramedic Scholarship Program

Overview

In the 2023 higher education omnibus act, the legislature established and funded a new temporary paramedic scholarship program administered by the Office of Higher Education (OHE). See 2023 Laws Ch. 41, art. 2, § 31. The program provided \$5,000 scholarships to Minnesota residents enrolled in paramedic programs at public and private Minnesota postsecondary institutions. The most recent mandated report on that program is available online here.

This bill would make that program permanent and provide it with ongoing funding.

Summary

Section Description

1 Establishment.

Amends the 2023 law's establishment subdivision to reflect the scholarship program becoming ongoing, rather than temporary.

2 Reporting.

Amends the 2023 law's reporting requirements for the program to reflect it becoming ongoing, rather than temporary.

3 Appropriation.

Appropriates \$3,200,000 per year to OHE for the scholarship program. Sets out the allowable uses for the funds. The program previously received \$3,200,000 in onetime funding in FY24 that was made available until June 30, 2026, or until expended.

4 Revisor instruction.

Instructs the revisor to codify the program's language in the 2023 law into Minnesota Statutes.

Section Description

5 Repealer.

Repeals the expiration subdivision for the program from the 2023 law.
