Estimated ARPA Funding to MDH

- ARPA is providing an estimated \$287 million in direct grant funding to MDH for COVID-19 response and relief in the state
- Our initial funding estimate of \$868M was based upon the distribution proportion from earlier federal COVID legislation and awards (March and December 2020)
- Guidance on final amounts is expected within 30 days and the state must certify allowable uses within 30-45 days thereafter
- MDH is applying for one competitive award at this time
