The Y is committed to youth employment supports. Our Career Pathways program is holistic, helping youth develop power soft skills, gain workforce readiness skills, and access on-the-job experiences and a professional network. We put youth on a path to careers that match their skills and interests, and address employers' needs for a workplace ready and diverse workforce. We provide 1:1 coaching through staff who help youth navigate challenges and solve problems as well as large group opportunities, and we offer paid internship experiences for older youth and stipended internship experiences for younger people.

Career Pathways provides a general introduction to the workforce and prepares youth with foundational employment and career readiness skills. This is critical as large populations enter retirement and extremely low unemployment rates. By helping young people access careers we also more deeply integrate them within community and advance their personal success, while supporting a flourishing economy for Minnesota.
