
MMB by the Numbers

With 270 full time employees, MMB's work touches every dollar, agency and position in the State of Minnesota


- Accounting issues 49,000 vendor payments a week
- Payroll processes 50,000 paychecks biweekly
- Budget coordinates biennial budget-setting process for more than **100** state entities
- Debt Management oversees
 \$8 billion in public debt

- Economic Analysis prepares **twice-a-year** economic forecasts
- State Employee Insurance manages benefits for **132,000** employees, family, and retirees
- Labor Relations negotiates **10** state employee contracts and **2** plans
- Enterprise Communications produces over 100 employee-centered messages a year

MMB manages over \$3.6 billion annually



MMB's annual operating budget is \$56 million



MMB Accomplishments

- Received the **highest bond ratings** from all three major rating agencies
- Returned more than \$300 million in state COVID appropriations to the general fund by maximizing federal resources
- Published evaluation research in the Journal of the American Medical Association's Health Forum
- Worked with cabinet agencies to directly certify nearly **200,000 families** for free or reduced-cost school meals



- Improved employee participation in the state's health insurance program to 94% in 2023
- Increased knowledge level in 98% of Enterprise Talent Development learning participants
