Overview

This bill appropriates money for self-advocacy services and supports for persons with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

Summary

Section Description

1 Appropriation; services for persons with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

Paragraph (a) appropriates \$143,000 in each year of the fiscal year 2022-2023 biennium from the general fund to the commissioner of human services for a grant to an organization governed by people with intellectual and developmental disabilities and administering a statewide network of disability groups to maintain and promote self-advocacy services and supports for persons with intellectual and developmental disabilities. Lists purposes for which grant money must be used.

Paragraph (b) appropriates \$105,000 in each year of the fiscal year 2022-2023 biennium from the general fund to the commissioner of human services for a grant to an organization governed by people with intellectual and developmental disabilities and administering a statewide network of disability groups to provide subgrants to organizations in Minnesota to conduct outreach to persons working and living in institutional settings to provide education and information about community options. Requires grant money to be used to deliver peer-led skill training sessions in six regions of the state to help people with intellectual and developmental disabilities understand specified community service options.
