Bill Description

This bill prohibits a person from disposing of a pesticide container by burning.

Assumptions

The MDA assumes noncompliance with this bill will be handled through the established complaint process, only investigating noncompliance when the department has received a complaint. In the last five years the MDA has received minimal complaints regarding the burning of pesticide containers and assumes there will be no fiscal impact to the agency on this bill.

It is assumed burning and incineration are two different methods for disposing of pesticide containers and incineration is still an acceptable method.
