

1.1 ..... moves to amend H.F. No. 766 as follows:

1.2 Page 4, after line 11, insert:

1.3 "Sec. 5. [21.915] PROHIBITED DISPOSAL METHODS.

1.4 A person must not dispose of seed treated or coated with neonicotinoid pesticide in a  
1.5 manner inconsistent with the product label, where applicable, or by:

1.6 (1) burial near a drinking water source or any creek, stream, river, lake, or other surface  
1.7 water;

1.8 (2) composting; or

1.9 (3) incinerating within a home or other dwelling.

1.10 Sec. 6. RULEMAKING REQUIRED.

1.11 The commissioner of agriculture, in consultation with the commissioner of the Pollution  
1.12 Control Agency and the University of Minnesota, must promulgate rules under Minnesota  
1.13 Statutes, chapter 14, providing for the safe and lawful disposal of unwanted or unused seed  
1.14 that is treated or coated with pesticide. The rules must clearly identify the regulatory  
1.15 jurisdiction of state agencies and local governments with regard to such seed."

1.16 Renumber the sections in sequence and correct the internal references

1.17 Amend the title as follows:

1.18 Page 1, line 4, after the semicolon, insert "regulating disposal of certain seeds; requiring  
1.19 rulemaking;"
