1.10 other legal entity, every officer, director, manager, and general partner of the entity, who
1.11 seeks a license issued by a county or city to operate a business:

1.12 (1) that qualifies as an adult entertainment establishment under section 617.242,
1.13 subdivision 1; or

1.14 (2) providing massage services."

1.15 Page 1, line 17, delete "employment or applicant for"

1.16 Page 2, line 8, delete "employment or"

1.17 With the recommendation that when so amended the bill be placed on the General
1.18 Register.
