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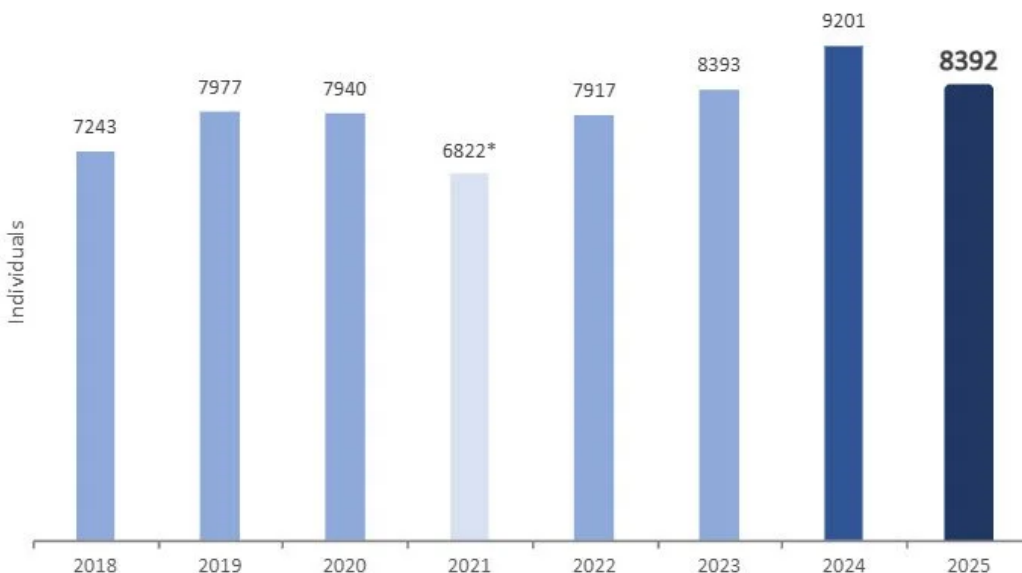
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2025 Point-in-Time Count Results

NOVEMBER 20, 2025

The results of the 2025 Point-in-Time (PIT) count are in! The annual federal mandate counts the number of individuals living outside and staying in temporary shelters across Minnesota on a single night in January. This year's PIT count found **8392 individuals experiencing homelessness in Minnesota**. The results reflect an 8.8% decrease compared to last year's total (Figure I).
