

1.1 Senator moves to amend the delete-everything amendment (A22-0484) to
1.2 H.F. No. 3872 as follows:

1.3 Page 6, delete lines 8 to 20 and insert:

1.4 "(b) \$5,050,000 in fiscal year 2023 is in
1.5 addition to the workforce development
1.6 scholarships amount appropriated in Laws
1.7 2021, First Special Session chapter 2, article
1.8 1, section 3, subdivision 3, paragraph (e). Of
1.9 this appropriation, up to \$200,000 is available
1.10 in each year to administer the program. Of this
1.11 appropriation, \$800,000 in fiscal year 2023 is
1.12 for scholarships to students enrolled in their
1.13 first term in an allied health technicians'
1.14 program, which is a category under the
1.15 workforce development scholarship health
1.16 care services. A student may receive the allied
1.17 health technician scholarship only once. The
1.18 \$800,000 is available until June 30, 2025, and
1.19 of this amount, \$24,000 is available for
1.20 administering the allied health technician
1.21 scholarships. The base for this appropriation
1.22 is increased by \$3,750,000 in fiscal year 2024
1.23 and later."
