Federal Administrative Funding

Federal funds directly support priority MDE programs benefiting Minnesota's students and educators.

- MDE spends about 15% of its federal budget on employee compensation and other agency operating costs. The remainder is spent on aids and grants.
- Accounting conventions greatly affect how federal administrative spending is reported between payroll and nonpayroll.

State Operating and Administrative Funding

- MDE is appropriated various operating budgets as well as administrative carveouts for grants and other programs.
- The governor's operating adjustment recommendation will allow MDE to continue providing high quality services despite rising costs for payroll and other purchases.
- MDE is focused on good governance, efficiency, and supporting programs providing the greatest benefit to students and educators.

Special Administrative Funding

MDE utilizes special revenue funds for its more unique funding sources.

- MDE is reimbursed by the federal government for many of its indirect costs supporting federal programs, such as finance staff, human resources, and IT services.
- MDE receives competitive awards and gifts from external partners to support the agency's priorities.
- MDE partners with other state agencies through interagency agreements.
