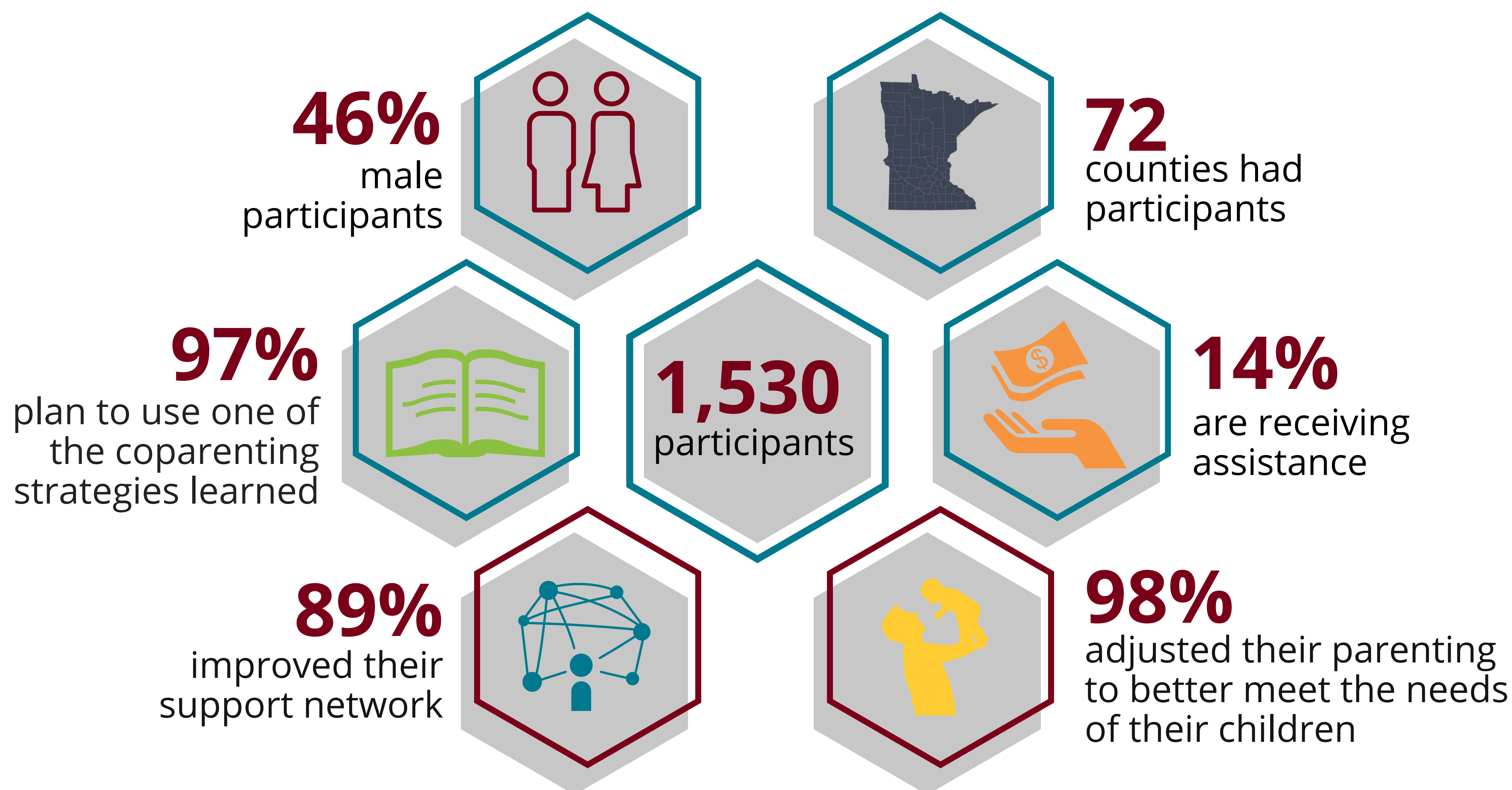




# 2020 Parents Forever report

Parents Forever meets all 25 minimum standards required by Minnesota Statute 518.157 for Minnesota court-ordered parent education. The course takes a minimum of 8 hours to complete.
