| 1 | <p><b>Conduct of hearings.</b></p> <p>Clarifies the procedure for a hearing with the administrative hearing office when the commissioner for the Department of Human Rights forwards a decision to them after a contested case. This bill would require that after the commissioner issues a decision, and a party requests an administrative hearing, the commissioner has 30 days to send the case to the Administrative Appeals Office, and the hearing is held consistent with the administrative hearing office's statutes in Chapter 14.</p> |
