Creating 60+ new jobs annually across new, existing, and expanding businesses.

Promoting community-building in the cultural district by drawing 5,000 people to Dreamland on 38th for events each year.

Building-up the community to ensure access to the essential ingredients for economic and social success, including living-wage jobs, health coverage, good schools, affordable homes, transportation choices, thriving businesses, safe and walkable streets, parks, and playgrounds and healthy food.
