1.3 "Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 609.2241, subdivision 2, is amended to read:

1.4 Subd. 2. **Crime.** It is a crime, which may be prosecuted under section 609.17, 609.185,
1.5 609.19, 609.221, 609.222, 609.223, 609.2231, or 609.224, for a person who knowingly
1.6 harbors an infectious agent, other than human immunodeficiency virus (HIV), to transfer,
1.7 if the crime involved:

1.8 (1) sexual penetration with another person without having first informed the other person
1.9 that the person has a communicable disease;

1.10 (2) transfer of blood, sperm, organs, or tissue, except as deemed necessary for medical
1.11 research or if disclosed on donor screening forms; or

1.12 (3) sharing of nonsterile syringes or needles for the purpose of injecting drugs.

1.13 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2023, and applies to crimes
1.14 committed on or after that date."
