Overview

H.F. 3626 would amend the definition of "brewer" to include any person that owns a malt liquor brand and would modify the definition of "beer" to include malt substitutes. In addition, the definition of "beer" would include any beverage meeting the definition of malt liquor.

Summary

Section Description

1 Brewer.

Amends the definition of "brewer" to include a person that owns a malt liquor brand. Current law defines a brewer as a person that manufactures malt liquor for sale.

2 Malt liquor.

Amends the definition of malt liquor to include non-distilled beverages made by the fermentation of malt substitutes such as rice, grain, sugar, or molasses. Also defines "beer" as any beverage meeting the definition of "malt liquor."
