1.2 was referred:

1.3 H. F. No. 1379, A bill for an act relating to health; authorizing the use of nonopioid
1.4 directives; establishing immunity for certain acts or failures to act; amending Minnesota
1.5 Statutes 2024, sections 145C.01, by adding subdivisions; 145C.17; proposing coding for
1.6 new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 145C.

1.7 Reported the same back with the following amendments:

1.8 Page 2, delete lines 30 and 31 and insert:

1.9 "(1) the patient is being treated, in emergency circumstances, in a hospital setting or in
1.10 a setting outside a hospital;"

1.11 Page 3, delete line 12 and insert "directive; for the administration of an opioid in the
1.12 circumstances in subdivision 3, paragraph (b), to a patient with a nonopioid directive; or
1.13 for the inadvertent administration of an opioid to a patient with a nonopioid"

1.14 With the recommendation that when so amended the bill be re-referred to the Committee
1.15 on Health Finance and Policy.
