This bill amends 18B by updating certain sections of 18B.32, 18B.33, and 18B.34.

**Assumptions**

The revised language of 18B.32, 18B.33, and 18B.34 statutes, will provide better clarity on the recertification and financial responsibility proof requirements for structural, commercial, and noncommercial pesticide applicators. Revision of these statutes will not affect the current license requirements of structural, commercial, and noncommercial pesticide applicators rather it will streamline the licensing processes and bring clarity to the requirements related to license renewal.
