Repeals Minnesota Rules, parts 7023.0150; 7023.0200; 7023.0250; and 7023.0300.

Assumptions

- 1. This analysis only addresses the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA).
- 2. Minnesota Rules, parts 7023.0150; 7023.0200; 7023.0250; and 7023.0300 only apply to one model year of vehicles due to changes, subsequent to the Minnesota Rules being adopted, with the incorporated by reference California Code of Regulations. The staff time required for data analysis and reporting associated with the Minnesota rules is nominal; therefore, repeal of the rule would have insignificant cost savings to the agency.
- **3.** Removal of references to Minnesota Rules, parts 7023.0150; 7023.0200; 7023.0250; and 7023.0300 Clean Cars data from the website would be minimal and staff time to do so absorbed.
