Overview

This bill adjusts some speed thresholds, from 30 to 35 miles per hour, for implements of husbandry and other vehicles related to towing, use of taillights, slow-moving vehicle emblems, and load covering. Effective August 1, 2025.

Summary

Section Description

1 Requirements; exception.

Increases the speed at which an implement of husbandry can be towed without taillights and license plate illumination being required, from 30 to 35 miles per hour.

2 Displaying emblem; rules.

Increases the upper designed operating speed of various vehicles for which a slow-moving vehicle emblem is required to be displayed, from 30 to 35 miles per hour. Increases the speed at which an empty implement of husbandry can be towed without removing a slow-moving vehicle emblem, from 30 to 35 miles per hour.

3 **Speed.**

Increases the maximum allowed speed when operating or towing an implement of husbandry, from 30 to 35 miles per hour.

4 Securing load; exceptions.

Increases the maximum allowed speed in which trash or debris can be transported without the load being covered, from 30 to 35 miles per hour.
