Overview

Extended time revenue provides additional money to school districts participating in a State-Approved Alternative Program (SAAP). State-Approved Alternative Programs are delivered through Area Learning Centers (ALCs), Alternative Learning Programs (ALPs), targeted services activities, and through contract alternative schools. Extended time revenue generally does not cover enrichment courses but is limited to coursework provided through a SAAP.

H.F. 105 authorizes extended time revenue for pupils enrolled in a career and technical education or science, technology, engineering, or math course offered for secondary credit and authorizes these courses to be provided outside of the regular school day (and in addition to a student's regular academic coursework).
