### **Overview**

This bill modifies provisions in Chapter 326B, which applies to construction codes and licensing, by raising a Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry reporting requirement threshold and by requiring the commissioner of labor and industry to establish a cost per square foot valuation of certain residential properties for the purpose of municipal building permit fees.

# **Summary**

## Section Description

#### 1 Annual report.

Changes the threshold for construction and development-related fee collections in municipal annual reports to the Department of Labor and Industry to fees collected in excess of \$7,000.

## 2 Valuation.

Requires the commissioner of labor and industry to establish a cost per square foot valuation of certain residential properties and associated accessory utility buildings for the purpose of setting building permit fees by municipalities.
