BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION; AGE WELL AT HOME.
- 1.6

\$3,000,000 in fiscal year 2026 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner
- 1.7

of human services for a grant to Age Well at Home to establish the Minnesota Age in Place
- 1.8

Network. Eligible uses of grant money are providing home modifications and safety
- 1.9

renovations at the owner-occupied homes of older low- to moderate-income homeowners.
- 1.10

No single modification or renovation project may exceed \$20,000. Age Well at Home may
- 1.11

also use up to ten percent of the grant money for administrative expenses attributable to
- 1.12

establishing, expanding, and maintaining the Minnesota Age in Place Network.
