1.10 support teams to facilitate transition back to the community or to the least restrictive level
1.11 of care from inpatient psychiatric settings, emergency departments, inpatient hospitalization,
1.12 juvenile detention facilities, residential treatment facilities, and child and adolescent
1.13 behavioral health hospitals. Any unexpended amount in fiscal year 2022 is available through

2.5 for mental health and substance use disorder, to modify and sustain its children's residential
2.6 treatment programs in Minnesota. Grant funds must be used to implement a planned
2.7 consolidation of existing children's residential treatment programs and to create a specialized
2.8 children's residential treatment program campus for children and youth with complex,
