1.3 "Sec. 3 Minnesota Statutes 2025 Supplement, section 142B.68, subdivision 9, is amended
1.4 to read:

1.5 Subd. 9. **Notices.** (a) A licensed child care center must notify all parents and legal
1.6 guardians who apply to enroll or enroll a child in the center about the use of video security
1.7 cameras in the facility. At the time of a child's enrollment, the center must:

1.8 (1) notify all parents and legal guardians about the right to decline to have a child recorded
1.9 on the video security cameras;

1.10 (2) obtain consent in writing in a form and manner prescribed by the commissioner from
1.11 all parents and legal guardians authorizing the video recording of each child; and

1.12 (3) provide parents and legal guardians with the video security camera policy required
1.13 under subdivision 8.

1.14 (b) A licensed child care center must post a sign at each facility entrance accessible to
1.15 visitors that states: "Video security cameras are present to record persons and activities."

1.16 Sec. 4 Minnesota Statutes 2025 Supplement, section 142B.68, is amended by adding a
1.17 subdivision to read:

1.18 Subd. 11. **Camera use prohibition.** (a) If a majority of parents and legal guardians of
1.19 children enrolled in the licensed child care center do not provide written consent under
1.20 subdivision 9, paragraph (a), clause (1), the center is exempt from this section and must not
1.21 install new or use installed video security cameras.

1.22 (b) The center must review the number of parents and legal guardians that have provided
1.23 written consent yearly. If after the yearly review a center that was required to use video

- 2.1 security cameras becomes exempt under paragraph (a) or a center that was exempt under
- 2.2 paragraph (a) becomes required to use video security cameras, the center must provide the
- 2.3 notices required under subdivision 9, paragraph (a). The center must include with the notices
- 2.4 the date on which video recording will begin or end."
