*In addition to the uses authorized under the student support personnel statute, section 124D.901, HF3493-DE1 allows a school board to adopt a resolution, after allowing for public testimony at a regularly scheduled board meeting, to allow student support personnel aid to be used for any allowable safe schools revenue (M.S. 126C.44) purpose.

**HF3493-DE1 states that if grants from the 2024 appropriation of \$24.332 million have not yet been awarded as of the effective date, the commissioner may reopen the grant application process, adjust preliminary grant amounts, and award additional grants, with expanded eligibility for Tribal contract schools and nonpublic schools.
