1.16 "(e) District efforts to develop, implement, or improve instruction or curriculum as a
1.17 result of this section must be consistent with sections 120B.10, 120B.11, and 120B.20."

1.18 Page 2, line 11, delete "2023-2024" and insert "2024-2025"

1.19 Page 2, line 23, after "assault" insert ", consistent with section 120B.234"

1.20 Page 2, line 24, delete "the" and insert "a"

1.21 Page 3, line 11, after "instruction" insert "and curriculum"

1.22 Page 3, line 30, delete "2024" and insert "2025"
