1.3        H. F. No. 1545, A bill for an act relating to liquor; permitting persons that are 17 years  
1.4        of age to serve alcoholic beverages; amending Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 340A.412,  
1.5        subdivision 10.

1.6        Reported the same back with the following amendments:

1.7        Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

1.8        "Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 340A.412, subdivision 10, is amended to  
1.9        read:

1.10        Subd. 10. **Employment of minors.** No person under 18 years of age may ~~serve or sell~~  
1.11        intoxicating liquor in a retail ~~intoxicating liquor~~ establishment that has an off-sale intoxicating  
1.12        liquor license. Notwithstanding section 181A.115, a person 17 years of age may serve or  
1.13        sell intoxicating liquor in a retail establishment that has an on-sale intoxicating liquor license,  
1.14        provided that the service or sale is supervised by an employee of the establishment who is  
1.15        over 17 years of age.

1.16        **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment."

1.17        With the recommendation that when so amended the bill be re-referred to the Committee  
1.18        on Workforce, Labor, and Economic Development Finance and Policy.
