- 1.2 relating to higher education; appropriating money for the addiction medicine
- 1.3 graduate medical education fellowship program at Hennepin County Medical
- 1.4 Center.
- 1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.6 Section 1. ADDICTION MEDICINE GRADUATE MEDICAL EDUCATION
- 1.7 FELLOWSHIP; APPROPRIATION.
- 1.8 (a) \$1,200,000 in fiscal year 2023 is appropriated from the general fund to the
- 1.9 commissioner of the Office of Higher Education for transfer to Hennepin County Medical
- 1.10 Center to support three physicians per year enrolled in an addiction medicine fellowship
- 1.11 program for five years, training a total of 15 physicians. This is a onetime appropriation.
- 1.12 (b) The appropriation under this section shall be used:
- 1.13 (1) to train fellows in:
- 1.14 (i) diagnostic interviewing;
- 1.15 (ii) motivational interviewing;
- 1.16 (iii) addiction counseling;
- 1.17 (iv) recognition and care of common acute withdrawal syndromes and complications;
- 1.18 (v) pharmacotherapies of addictive disorders;
- 1.19 (vi) epidemiology and pathophysiology of addiction;
- 1.20 (vii) identification and treatment of addictive disorders in special populations;

- 2.1 (viii) secondary interventions;
- 2.2 (ix) the use of screening and diagnostic instruments;
- 2.3 (x) inpatient care; and
- 2.4 (xi) working within a multidisciplinary team; and
- 2.5 (2) to prepare fellows to practice addiction medicine in rural and underserved areas of
- 2.6 the state.
