1.8 "Subdivision 1. **Definitions.** (a) For purposes of this section, the following terms have
1.9 the meanings given.

1.10 (b) "Assignment" means the designation of nursing tasks or activities to be performed
1.11 by another nurse or unlicensed assistive person.

1.12 (c) "Emergency" means a period when replacement staff are not able to report for duty
1.13 for the next shift or increased patient need, because of unusual, unpredictable, or unforeseen
1.14 circumstances such as, but not limited to, an act of terrorism, a disease outbreak, adverse
1.15 weather conditions, or natural disasters which impact continuity of patient care.

1.16 (d) "Emergency medical condition" means a condition manifesting itself by acute
1.17 symptoms of sufficient severity, including severe pain, such that the absence of immediate
1.18 medical attention could reasonably be expected to result in placing the individual's health
1.19 in serious jeopardy, serious impairment to bodily functions, or serious dysfunction of bodily
1.20 organs.

1.21 (e) "Facility" means:

1.22 (1) an acute care hospital licensed under sections 144.50 to 144.58; or

2.1 (2) any facility, regardless of the type of facility and regardless of the facility's license,
2.2 where patient care staff employed by the state provide patient care.

2.3 (f) "Nurse" has the meaning given in section 148.171, subdivision 9, and includes nurses
2.4 employed by the state of Minnesota.

2.5 (g) "Patient" means a patient of a facility.

2.6 (h) "Patient care staff" means a person in a nonsupervisory and nonmanagerial position
2.7 who provides direct care; who provides supportive, rehabilitative, or therapeutic services
2.8 to patients; or who directly provides nursing care to patients more than 60 percent of the
2.9 time, but who is not:

2.10 (1) a licensed physician;

2.11 (2) a physician assistant licensed under chapter 147A; or

2.12 (3) an advanced practice registered nurse licensed under sections 148.171 to 148.285,
2.13 unless working as a registered nurse."
