Bill Description

HF45 amends Minn. Stat. § 609.1056 (Military Veterans; Crimes Committed Because of Conditions Resulting from Service; Discharge and Dismissal) by adding a new subdivision 1a providing that at any time before sentencing a defendant may request that the court determine whether the defendant is eligible for deferred prosecution under the statute. The bill moves the existing provisions regarding records release and court determination from subdivision 2 to subdivision 1a.

Assumptions

Because the provisions of this bill do not modify the eligibility criteria or determination process, and instead simply clarify that a defendant's request for and the court's determination of eligibility can be made at any time before sentencing, the bill is not anticipated to increase or decrease the amount of time judges spend on these matters.

Expenditure and/or Revenue Formula

It is not anticipated that the provisions of this bill will have a significant fiscal impact on the Judicial Branch.
