1.4 Subd. 2. **Required contents.** (a) The rules adopted by the board must ~~require~~ include
1.5 the requirements established in paragraphs (b) through (f).

1.6 (b) Personnel hired on a part-time basis to provide event security must complete:

1.7 (1) 12 hours of in-person preassignment or on-the-job certified training within the first
1.8 21 days of employment, or evidence that the employee has successfully completed equivalent
1.9 training before the start of employment; and

1.10 (2) six hours a year of in-person certified continuing training.

1.11 (c) Personnel hired to provide regularly scheduled security work must complete:

1.12 (1) 40 hours of in-person preassignment or on-the-job certified training within the first
1.13 21 days of employment, or evidence that the employee has successfully completed equivalent
1.14 training before the start of employment; and

1.15 (2) 24 hours a year of in-person certified continuing training.

1.16 (d) Individuals who are armed with firearms or armed with weapons must complete an
1.17 additional six hours a year of in-person training beyond what is required in paragraphs (a)
1.18 and (b), which must include annual certification of the individual.

1.19 (e) An individual may not carry or use a weapon while undergoing on-the-job training
1.20 under this subdivision.

2.1 (f) Board certification of completion of certified training is required for a license holder,
2.2 qualified representative, Minnesota manager, partner, and employee to carry or use a firearm,
2.3 a weapon other than a firearm, or an immobilizing or restraint technique.

2.4 (g) Notwithstanding any statute or rule to the contrary, this clause is paragraphs (b), (c),
2.5 and (d) are satisfied if the employee provides a prospective employer with a certificate or
2.6 a copy of a certificate demonstrating that the employee successfully completed this the
2.7 required training prior to employment with a different Minnesota licensee and completed
2.8 this the required training within three previous calendar years, or successfully completed
2.9 this the required training with a Minnesota licensee while previously employed with a
2.10 Minnesota licensee. The

2.11 (h) A certificate of completion of training that is required under this section, or a copy
2.12 of the certificate, is the property of the employee who completed the training, regardless of
2.13 who paid for the training or how training was provided. Upon a current or former employee's
2.14 request, a current or former licensed employer must provide a copy of a certificate
2.15 demonstrating the employee's successful completion of training to the current or former
2.16 employee. The current or former licensed employer must not charge the employee a fee for
2.17 a copy of the certificate. The employee who completed the training is entitled to access a
2.18 copy of the certificate at no charge according to sections 181.960 to 181.966. A current or
2.19 former employer must comply with sections 181.960 to 181.966.

2.20 (i) For purposes of this section, "in-person" requires both the person receiving the training
2.21 and the trainer to be in-person at the same location. Training offered by video, computer,
2.22 self-study, or phone instruction does not satisfy the in-person requirement.
