1.2 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

1.3 "Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 13.43, subdivision 5a, is amended to read:

1.4 Subd. 5a. **Limitation on disclosure of certain personnel data.** (a) Notwithstanding
1.5 any other provision of this section, the following data relating to employees of a secure
1.6 treatment facility defined in section 253B.02, subdivision 18a, or section 253D.02,
1.7 subdivision 13; employees of a treatment program as defined in section 253D.02, subdivision
1.8 17; employees of a state correctional facility;² or employees of the Department of Corrections
1.9 directly involved in supervision of offenders in the community, ~~shall~~ must not be disclosed
1.10 to facility patients or clients, corrections inmates, or other individuals who facility or
1.11 correction administrators reasonably believe will use the information to harass, intimidate,
1.12 or assault any of these employees:

1.13 (1) place where previous education or training occurred;

1.14 (2) place of prior employment; and

1.15 (3) payroll timesheets or other comparable data, to the extent that disclosure of payroll
1.16 timesheets or other comparable data may disclose future work assignments, home address
1.17 or telephone number, the location of an employee during nonwork hours, or the location of
1.18 an employee's immediate family members.

1.19 (b) For employees of a secure treatment facility as defined in section 253B.02, subdivision
1.20 18a, or section 253D.02, subdivision 13, or employees of a treatment program as defined
1.21 in section 253D.02, subdivision 17, the final disposition of any disciplinary action together
1.22 with the specific reasons for the action and data documenting the basis of the action under
1.23 subdivision 2, paragraph (a), clause (5), must not be disclosed to facility patients or clients,

2.1 or other individuals that Direct Care and Treatment reasonably believes will use the
2.2 information to harass, intimidate, or assault any of these employees.

2.3 (c) Notwithstanding section 13.05, subdivision 12, a government entity that receives a
2.4 request for personnel data that may be subject to paragraph (a) or (b) is authorized to require
2.5 the requesting person to identify themselves and state a reason for their request.

2.6 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment and
2.7 applies to any data request pending on or received after that date."
