| 1 | <p>Biometric data; consent; safeguards.</p> <p>Subd. 1. Definition. Defines biometric data for purposes of this section.</p> <p>Subd. 2. Consent required. Requires consent in order to collect biometric data.</p> <p>Subd. 3. Prohibitions; safeguards; retention. Prohibits the sale of biometric data outside of specified circumstances. Imposes standards for the storage of biometric data. Requires destruction of stored biometric data after a certain period of time.</p> <p>Subd. 4. Enforcement. Provides for enforcement by the attorney general. Imposes a civil penalty of \$25,000 per violation.</p> <p>Subd. 5. Exemptions. Exempts “voiceprint data” retained by financial institutions under the federal Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act.</p> |
