Guardian ad Litem Board Purpose

• The State Guardian ad Litem Board (GALB) administers the Minnesota Guardian ad Litem Program which exists so that all children with a courtappointed Guardian ad Litem have their primary needs met and that each judicial officer is equipped to make informed decisions for each child within the confines of available resources.

The State Guardian ad Litem Program supports the statewide outcome of strong and stable families.



FY20/21 Program Progress

44 new staff hired to cover all juvenile mandated cases has helped:

- Protect children and prevent re-entry of children into the child protection system
- Ensure children receive appropriate services including trauma informed care
- Ensure physical and mental health, educational and cultural needs are met
- Ensure children are reunited with parents if it is in their best interest
- Ensure the GAL Board and Program are accountable to the citizens of the State of Minnesota
